

## CVPC Minutes

July 12, 2005

The meeting started at 7:10. Bob Quirk expressed some of his ideas on how a meeting should be run. Bob moved and Mike Knowland seconded to approve the June minutes. It passed.

There was discussion about communication. Questions in sued: How do people communicate with the committee? We have a P.O. Box 309 to receive communication. Who opens the mail? Do we get a designated person or bring it to the meeting as a whole? Nothing was decided. It was decided to put a recap of the meeting into the CV News. Judy Kidd and Jenny Lee will do that. Jenny motioned and Pam Doiron seconded .It was also proposed to add the agenda for the August meeting. Passed.

The Steering Committee makes proposals to the CVPC. Judy Kidd made a steering committee report. Judy also reported on the Land Use Strategies for Cuyama Valley from the county. Judy will contact Dave Ward from the county and see if he can e-mail us or come out and tell us what a contact person expects of the citizen groups. Bob Quirk put the names of the committees on the white board for people to sign up.

The committee tabled the community survey. Pam Dorion reported on the development of the website. There is not one yet, but she is finding out if we can link to other web sites that are affiliated with Cuyama Valley. The basic website should contain information about CVPC and have an e-mail address for people to write.

Jenny Lee reported that she could get 2 water-rights attorneys to come and talk to the CVPC in Sept. George Morgan moved and Michael Fife seconded to do it and add it to the Sept. newsletter.

Annie Cereghino and Jim Revelery reported that a meeting was held in Ventucopa concerning mining. They developed a letter and a petition was signed which will be sent to the governor and others.

There was discussion as to whether the letter and petition needed approval from the CVPC. No action taken. Ron Thrower has concerns about earthquakes and money for Cuyama Valley Recreation.

Mike Knowland made a report on “How to Make a Plan”. He showed examples of two land use plans and suggested that there are no protections for the community in these plans. We need to have our plan written to protect the Valley. Discussion followed.

Ron Thrower moved and George Morgan seconded to have a board and choose officers and have sub committees. Discussion followed, and it was approved. This will happen at the next meeting.
