

CVPAC Minutes

July 11, 2006

Bob Quirk called the meeting to order at 7:15.

Judy Kidd read the minutes of the June meeting. George Morgan moved and John Kidd seconded to approve. Passed

Bob Quirk gave an update on his meeting with Joe Centeno on July 5th. He stated there is a 50/50 ownership of the property for the swimming pool which has to be settled. The other owner besides the Rec. District is Estada Home Loan but only paperwork is required to settle the situation. If all goes well, they will be out, and all the property will go to the Rec. District. It will have to be determined if the Rec. District gives the property to the county, and also who will manage the pool. Two million dollars has been designated by the county for a pool in Cuyama. Bob also invited Mr. Centeno and Mr. Royster to the picnic on July 29th. Mr. Centeno also said that funding has been allotted to CVPAC to write a plan. There is a delay in building another bridge across Salisbury Wash next to the townsite. Mike Nolan stated that main problem is that the Dept of Public Works does not want to take the responsibility of the road from the bridge to the high school. Discussion followed. Bob also asked Mr. Centeno about the availability of posters showing the Village Concept to be used at the picnic.

Judy Kidd reported on two public hearings concerning the permitting of Bolthouse Farms in SLO County and Santa Barbara County. One will be in Cuyama on Aug. 25th.
