

**CVPAC Minutes**  
**April 10, 2007**

Old Business – John Kidd reported that he had contact Joe Centeno concerning the four questions we had from the previous meeting.

4. The date for the Troesh Mine planning committee meeting is May 30, 2007.

Jack Boyson, Joe Centeno's new assistant, has had a meeting in New Cuyama. The information published in the Cuyama Valley News was a framework for the writing of a plan. The four main areas the CVPAC had specified were air, water, zoning, and roads. Joe Centeno hopes to get back to Cuyama soon.

Judy Kidd reported on the MOU that Grimmway Farms has made with the APCD to try to reduce fugitive dust in the Valley. Jim Wegis moved and George Morgan seconded that we put a thank-you to Grimmway Farms in the Cuyama Valley News for their concerns and efforts. Passed.

Marty Eifrid told us about Google Earth and had examples of what it can do as far as zooming in on specific places on earth.
