

CVPAC M Minutes  
May 8, 2007

1. John Kidd called the meeting to order at 7:09.
2. Tom Mounts led the flag salute.
3. Judy Kidd read the April minutes. Mica Harris moved and Pam Doiron seconded to approve. Passed. Introductions were made because of new people at the meeting.
4. Old Business – John Kidd explained that as chairman he has tried to have the writing of the Land Use Strategy as the main focus of CVPAC, but because of the possibility of additional rock mines in Cuyama Valley and the effects they could have on the Valley, this issue has been discussed at our meetings. 1. John discussed his 4/18/07 meeting with Joe Centeno concerning a date and time when Joe could come to Cuyama. The date was to be 4/26/07. 2. At the 4/26 meeting, Mr. Centeno stated that the money for the swimming pool has been allocated. He'd like to see the money for the complete project allocated before they start the project. 3. Money for the Cal Trans project on Highway 166, left-hand turn lanes and bridge repair, has been allocated and is suppose to start in Aug. 07. 4. A group from Ojai met with a group from Cuyama on April 28, concerning the possible mines in Ventucopa. Groups are getting organized for the May, 30, 2007, Planning Committee meeting in Santa Maria. 4. John met with Jack Boysen on May, 7, to discuss the development of the Land Use Strategy meetings. It was concluded it would be best to start the plan in July after the budget has been finalized. Derek Johnson would be more readily available at that time.
5. New Business –
  - a. Marty Eifrid – showed the group a copy of his new webpage for the website for Cuyama Valley. Marty also gave a great power point program on a possible transportation system for Cuyama Valley that would link the Cuyama Airport with Santa Barbara Airport and Santa Maria Airport with a monorail system. It was definitely a lot of “food for thought”. Discussion followed.
  - b. Judy Kidd read an article from the L.A. Times concerning the rock trucks on Highway 33 and into Ojai.
  - c. Judy Kidd reported of a discussion she had with Jack Boysen as to how the procedure may go at the May 30 Planning Committee meeting.
6. Public Forum – There was discussion on the Cal Trans issues with Hiways 33 and 166 not being built to handle large, heavy truck traffic. Also discussion on the Williamson Act and its possible effect on the growth and development of Cuyama Valley. Also discussed were the effects of incorporation on Cuyama. Would it be cost effective?
